GENERAL DUTIES:

Provides psychosocial and crisis intervention consultations to patients in various hospital departments which includes inpatient areas (ICU, Med/Surg, OB), emergency room, surgical services and preventive medicine. Responsible for psychosocial assessment and planning in areas of perinatal social work, abuse, chemical dependency, mental/emotional/behavioral problems, domestic violence, suicide attempt/ideation/overdoses, traumatic medical incidents, dysfunctional relationships and end of life/death issues. Assists with Bioethics Committee functions.

EDUCATION AND TRAINING:

1. Masters degree in Social Work or Counseling required.
2. 1 year experience in social work or counseling required.
3. Proven leadership, communication and critical thinking skills required.
4. Knowledge of age-related and cultural issues with regard to the patient population served required.
5. Knowledge of behavior health and crisis intervention principles required.
6. BLS certification required.
7. Knowledge of hospital functions and processes desirable.
